**Authorized Non-Stormwater Discharges**  
**(per MS4 Permit # GP-0-24-001) for SUNY Buffalo State MS4**

The following activities that are sources of uncontaminated water are generally authorized to discharge through the SUNY Buffalo State operated MS4 (Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System):

1. Fire hydrant flushings;
2. Testing of firefighting equipment, provided that such equipment is for water only fire suppression;
3. Potable water sources including waterline flushings;
4. Irrigation drainage;
5. Lawn watering;
6. Uncontaminated (groundwater) infiltration and inflow (into a storm sewer);
7. Leakage from raw water conveyance systems;
8. Routine external building wash down which does not use detergents or other compounds;
9. Pavement wash waters where spills or leaks of toxic or hazardous materials, other than minor and routine releases from motor vehicles, have not occurred (unless such material has been removed) and where detergents are not used;
10. Air conditioning and steam condensate;
11. Springs;
12. Uncontaminated groundwater;
13. Foundation or footing drains where flows are not contaminated with process materials such as solvents; and
14. Discharges from firefighting activities only when the firefighting activities are emergencies/unplanned.
